













Put the verbs in brackets into Past Simple. Be a detective: read the text very carefully and find one detail which shows that Ms Jane Webb is lying.

At 11:22 p.m. on January 7, 2007, Ms. Jane Webb called the Toronto police to report a suicide. At 11:34 a police car(stop) in front of her house, and two policemen(get) out of the car. Ms. Webb(put) on a warm coat because it(be) cold and she waited for them in front of the house. She(take) them to the house across the street.
Surprisingly, the door (be) not closed. They entered the house and (find) the dead man. There was a small hole above his right eye, and there was a gun on the floor next to his right hand.
The policemen looked around but they (not touch) anything. They then (leave) the room and (tell) Ms. Webb that she (be) a very important witness. They asked her to go to her house and wait for them.
Inspector Greene and a team of experts arrived fifteen minutes later and the investigation(begin).
It was almost 2 a.m. when Inspector Greene finally (come) to speak to Ms. Webb. They (sit) at the kitchen table, (drink) a cup of coffee and she (tell) him about the crime.

Then I (run) to his house, but all the doors and windows were closed so I (take) a stone and (break) a window on the first floor and I climbed in.
Ms. Webb continued: `I (go) up the stairs to the study. I turned on the light and I(run) to the body, but there was nothing I could do for him. Then (leave) the house and called the police.
Now she (begin) to tremble. `I'm sorry,' she explained, `Mr James was also my boss. I work at his company as his accountant, and I know there was a reason for his suicide. The company(go) bankrupt, and I feel responsible for this accident because I(give) him the bad news, just this morning.'
The inspector looked at her but there was no sympathy in his eyes. He (say), in a very cold voice, `You are going to have to come down to police headquarters with me.'
